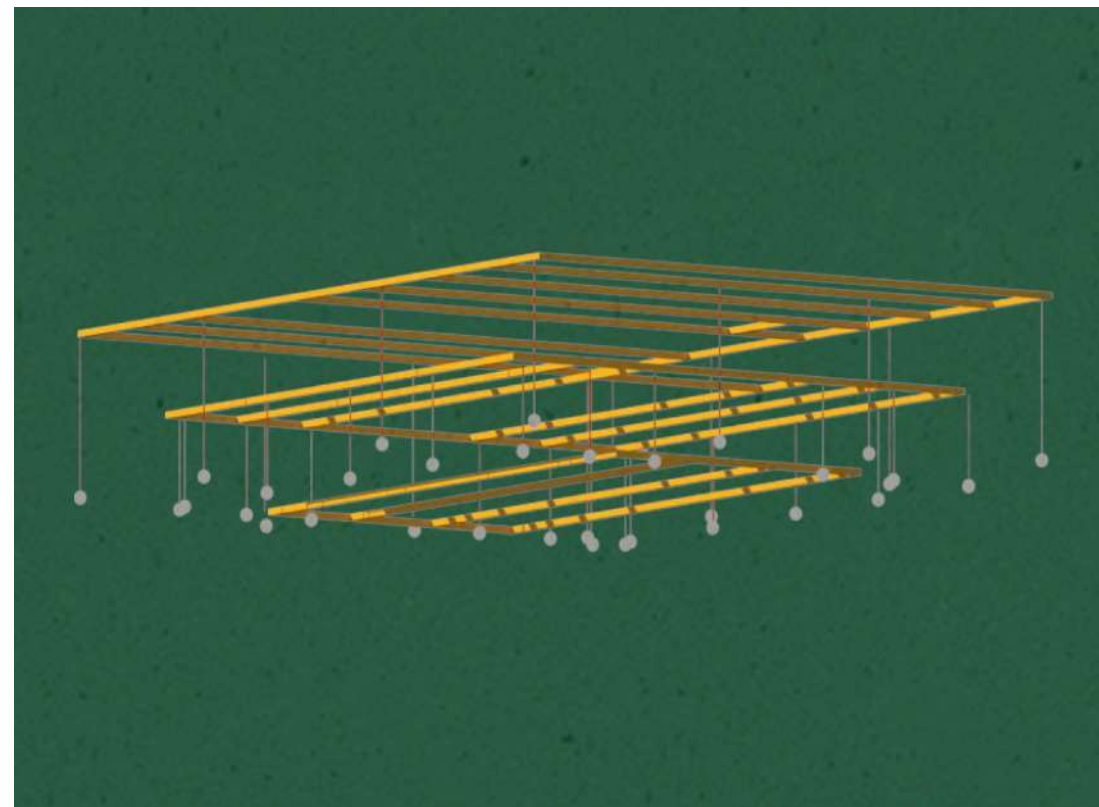
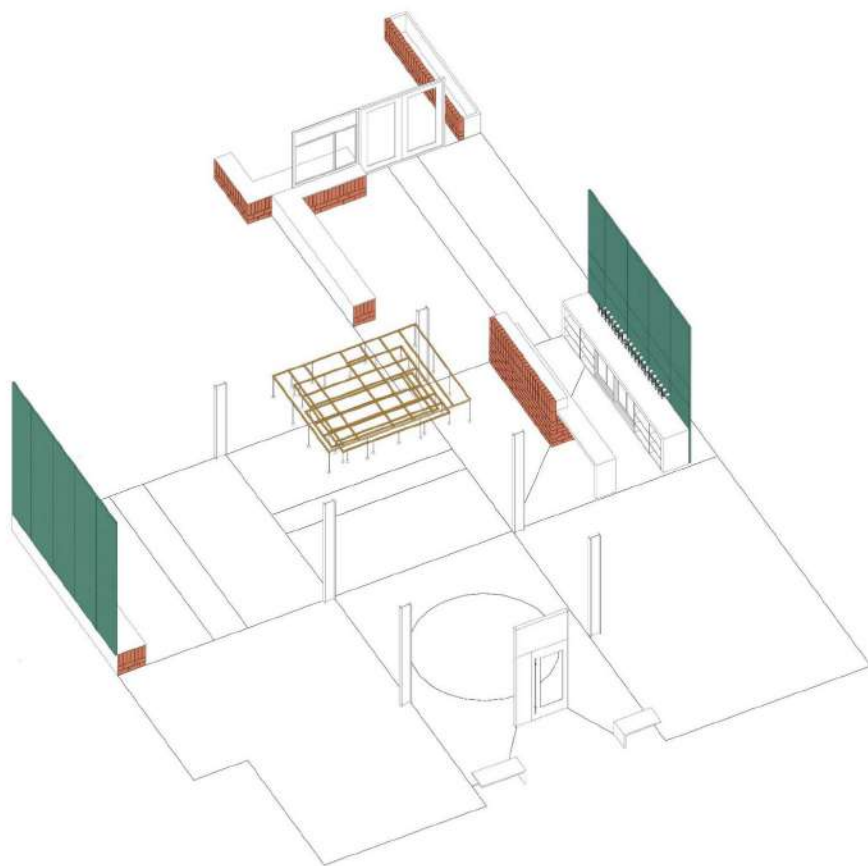
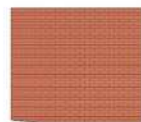
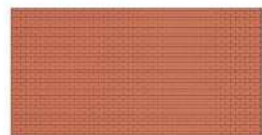




Figure 1.1.1. Section

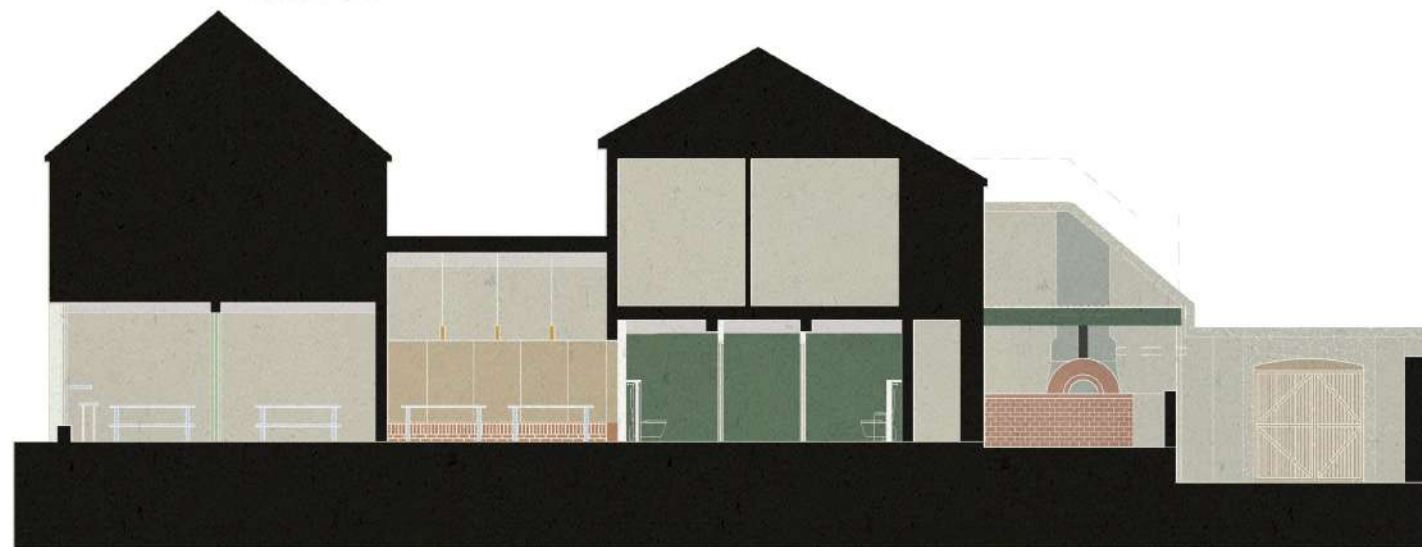
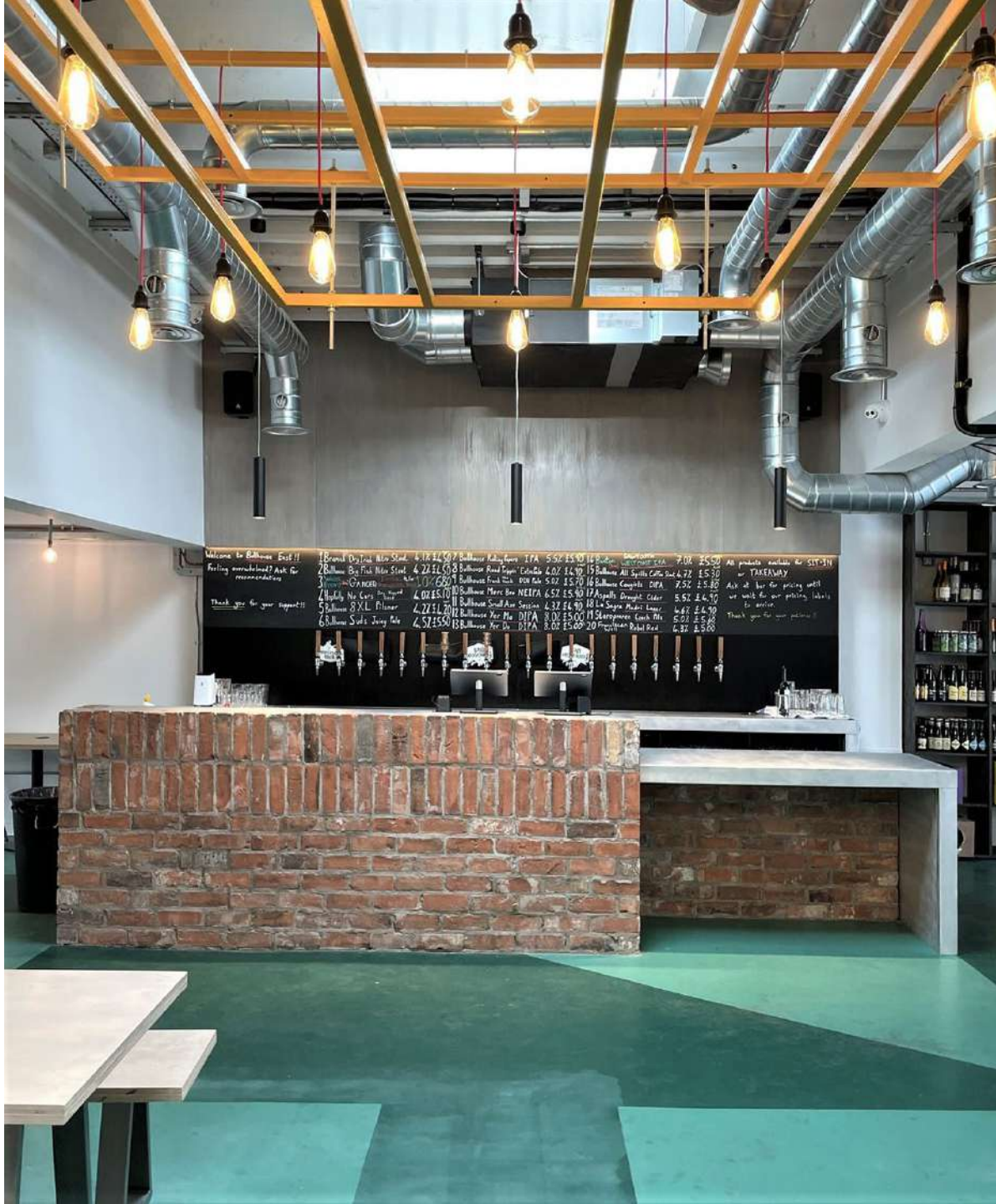


Figure 1.1.2. Section

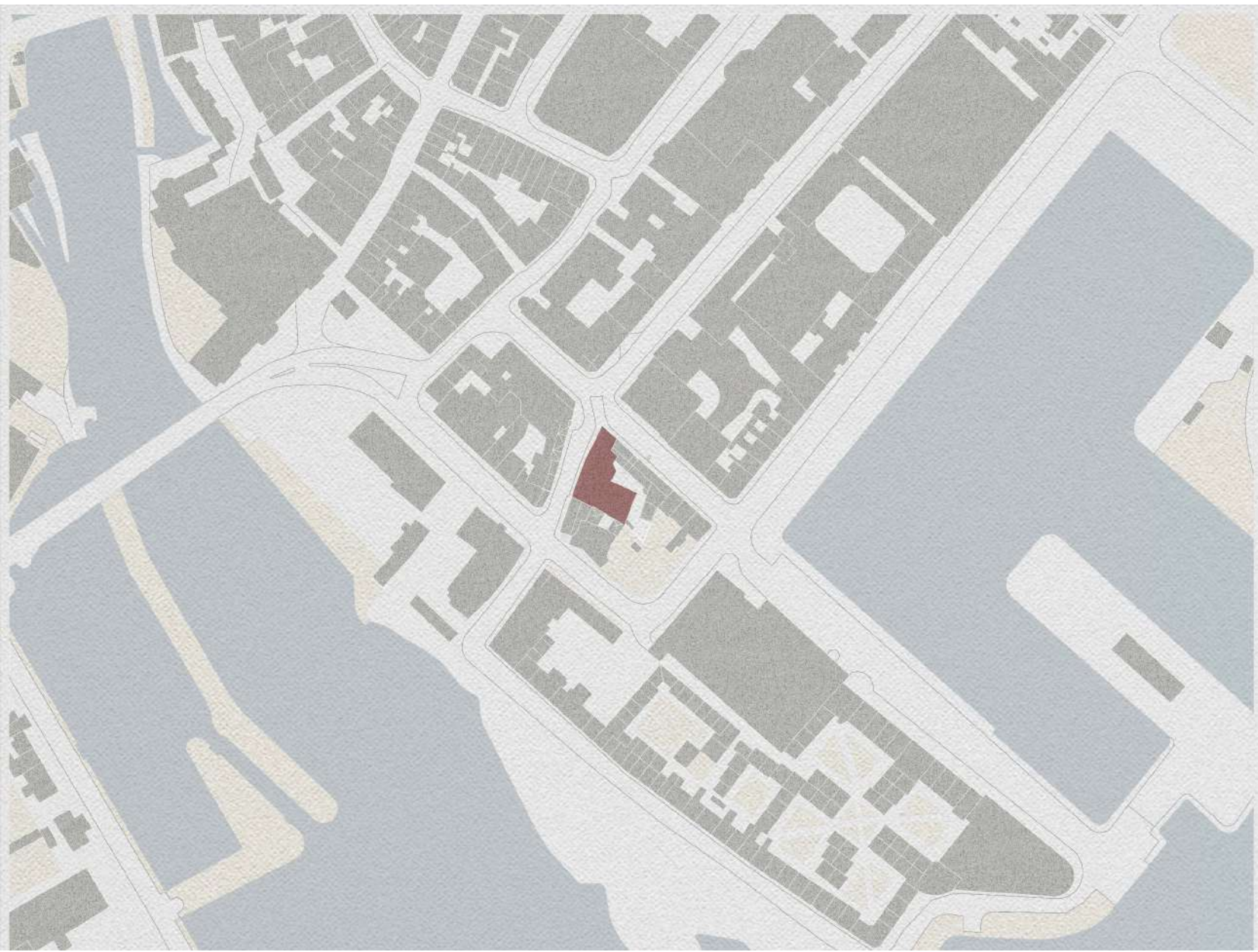


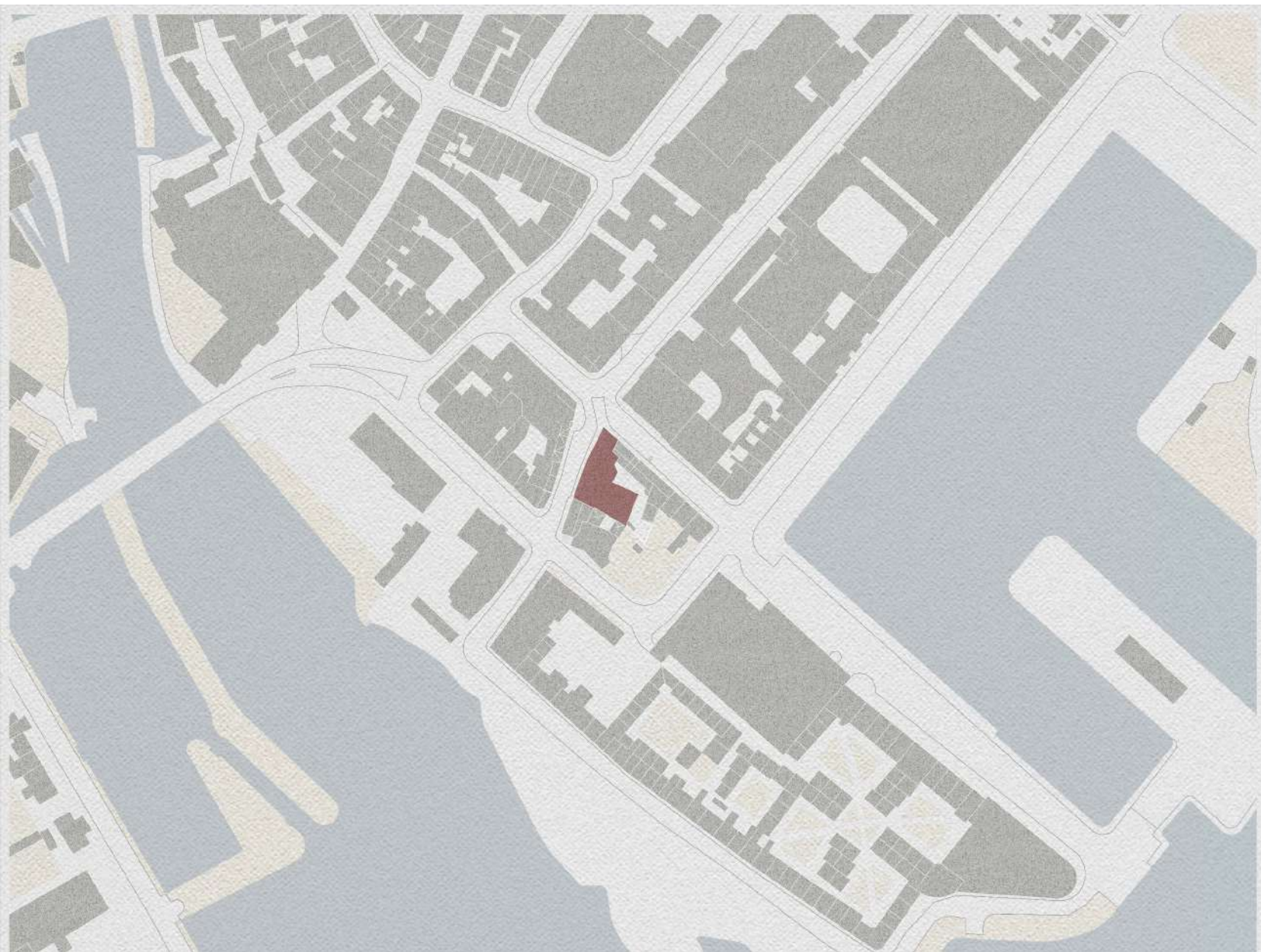


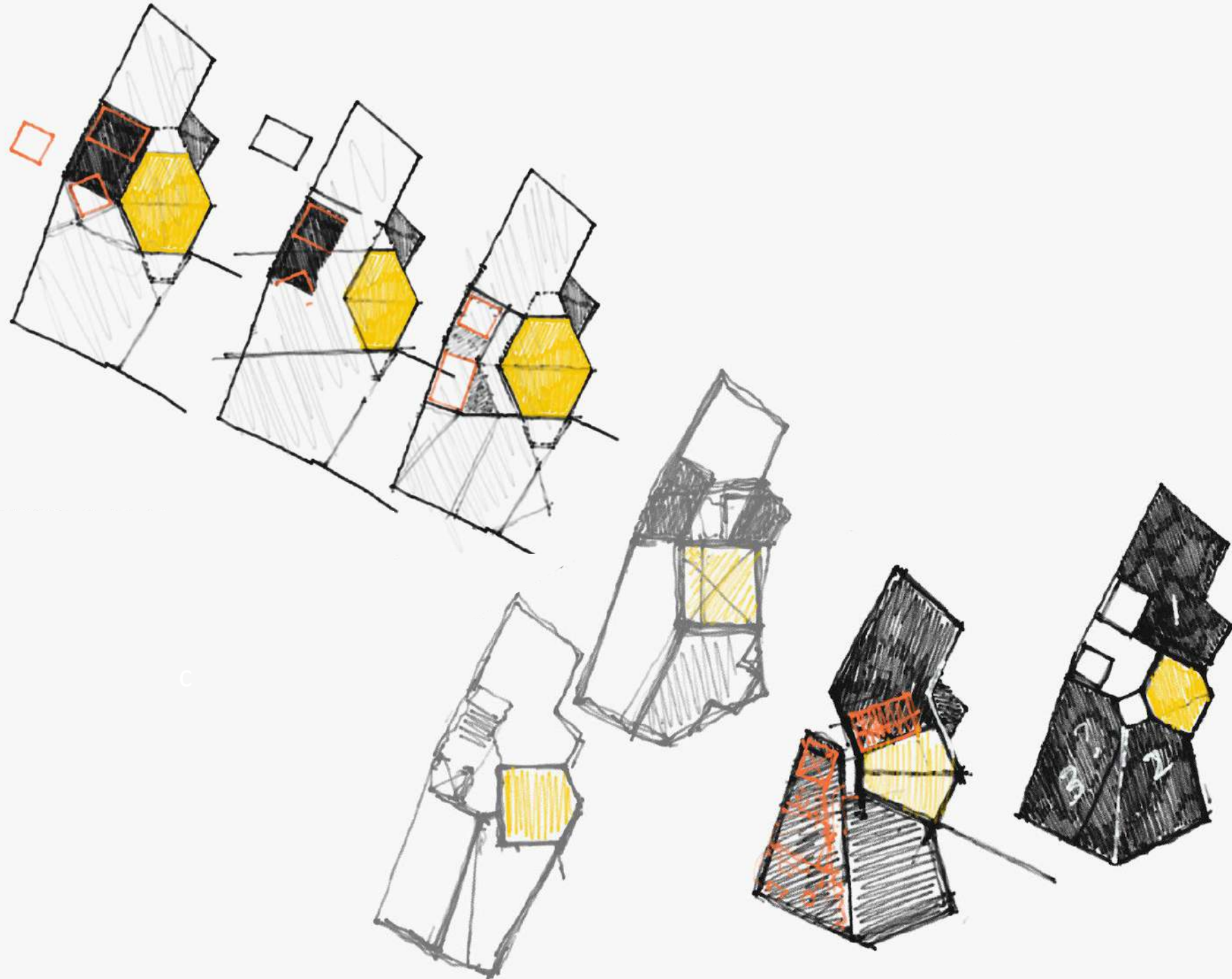


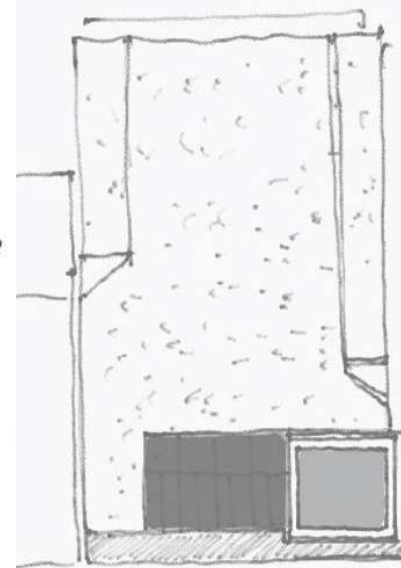
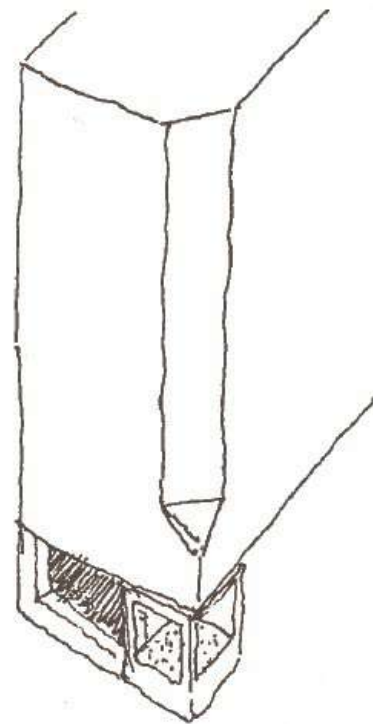
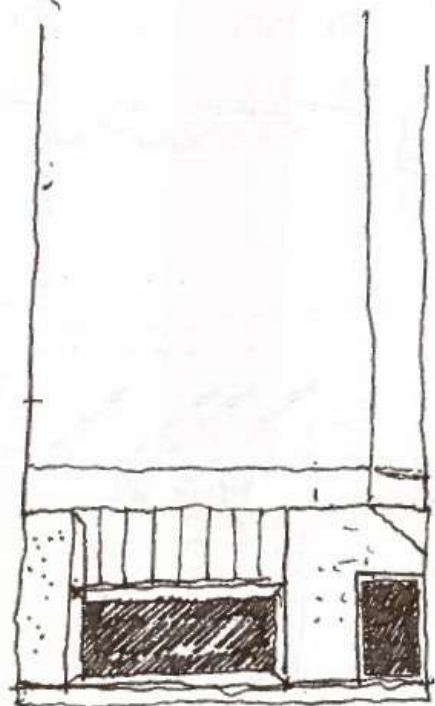
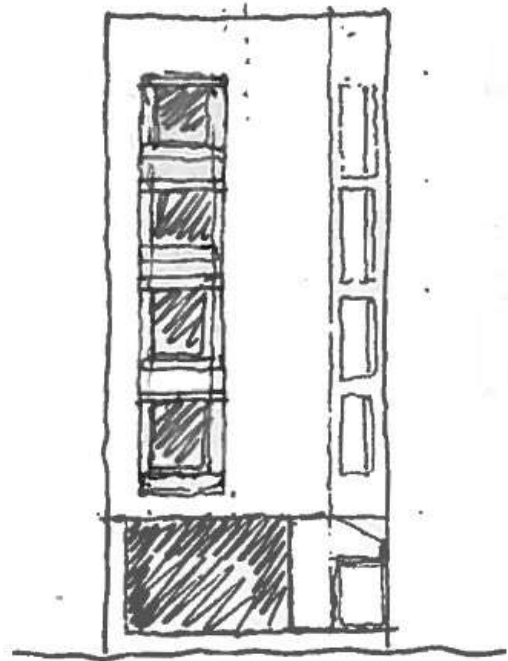


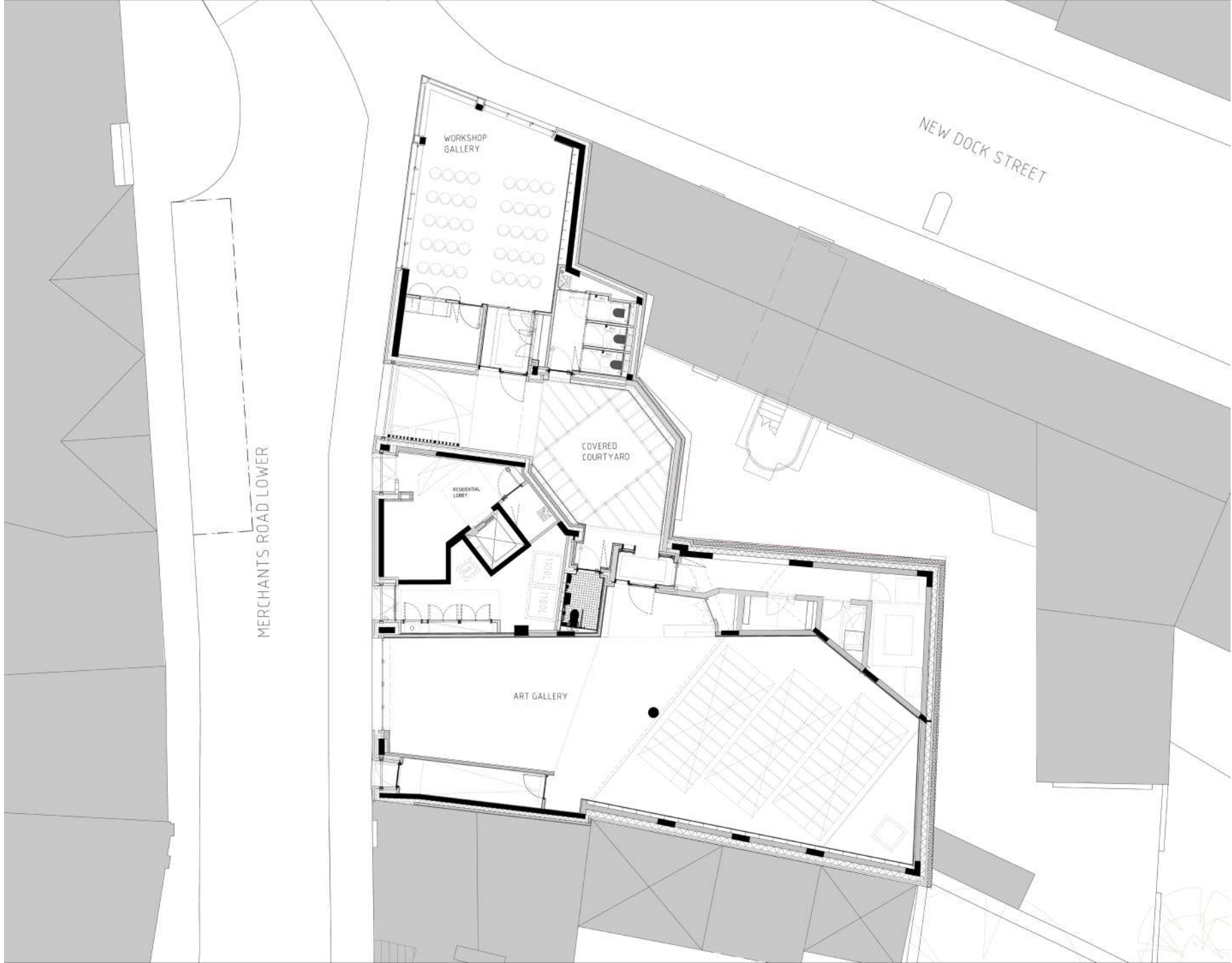


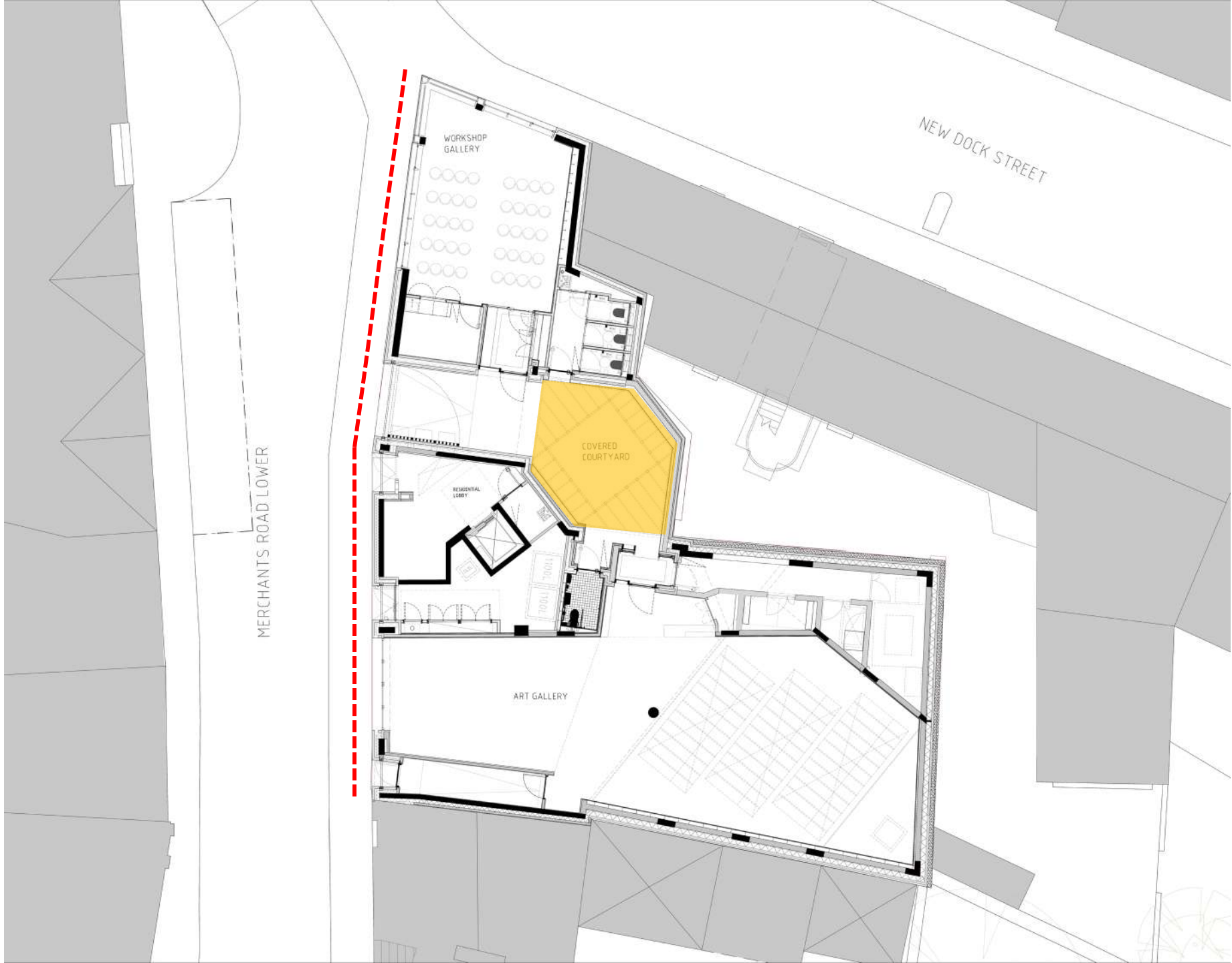


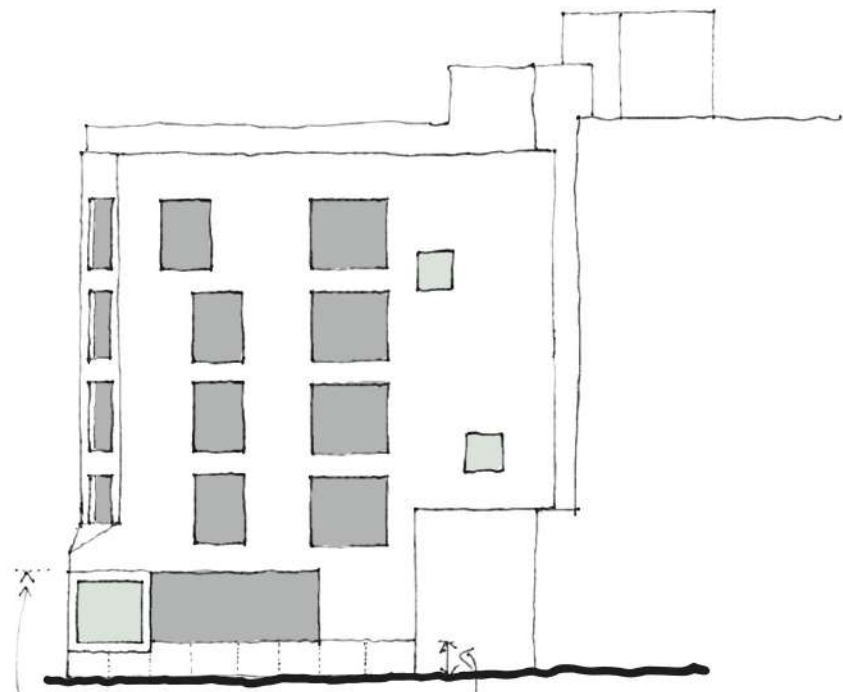






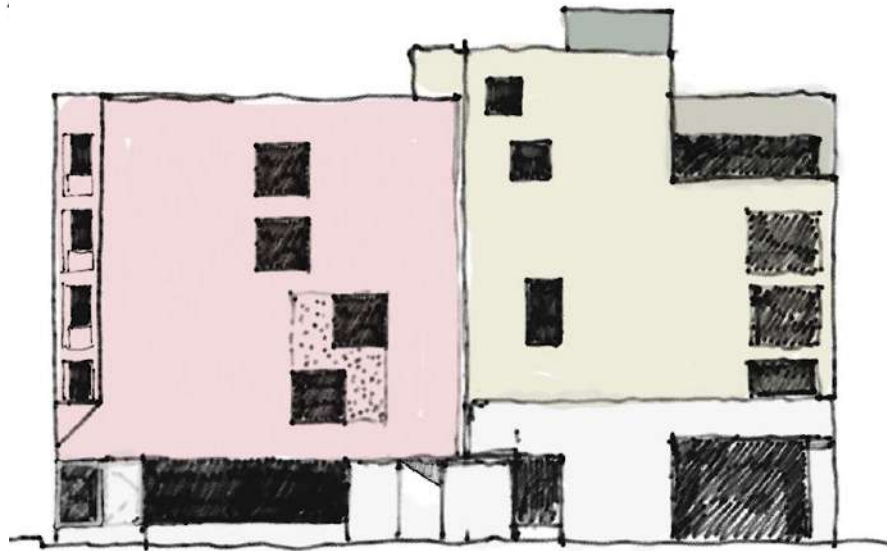




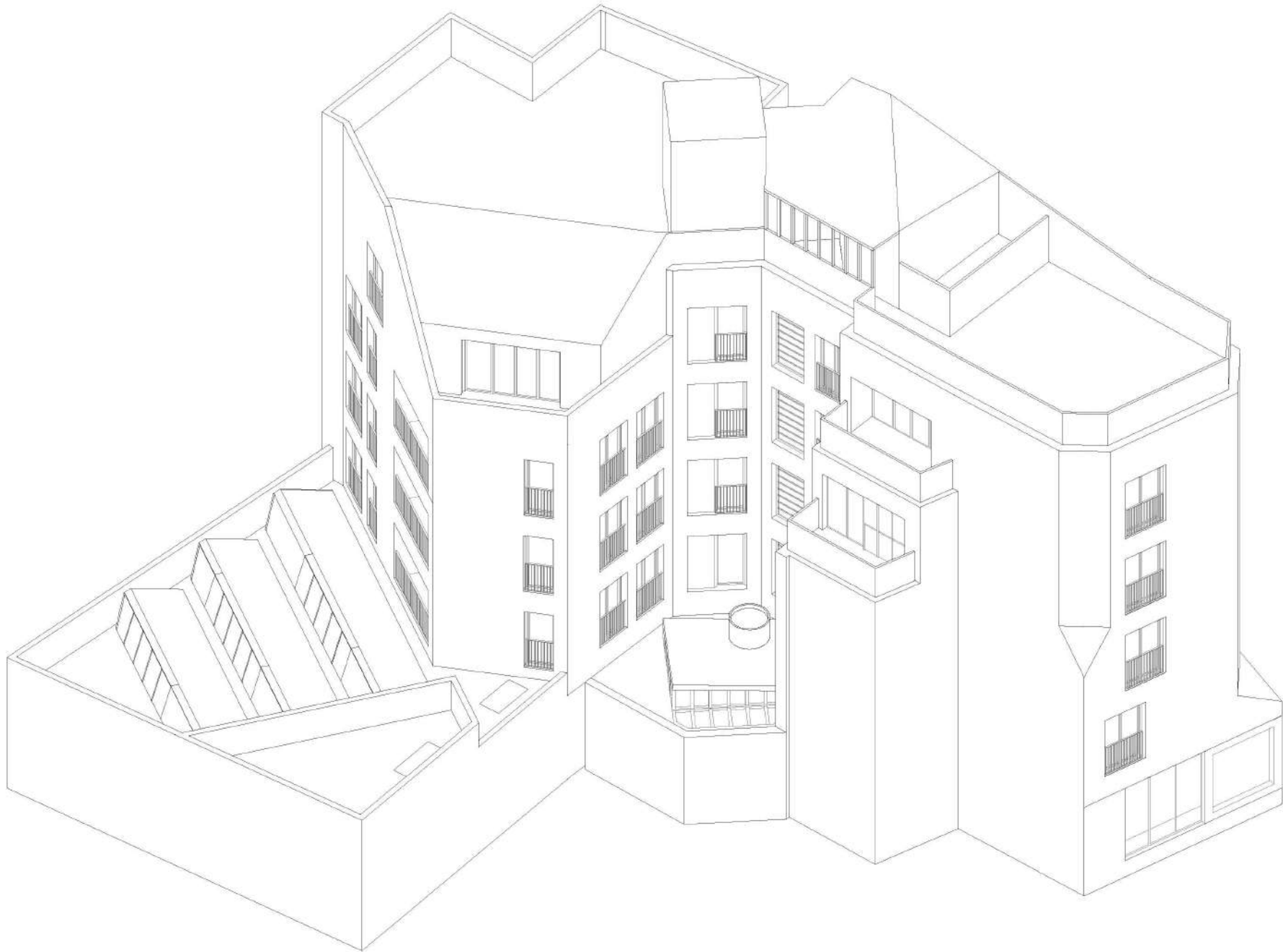

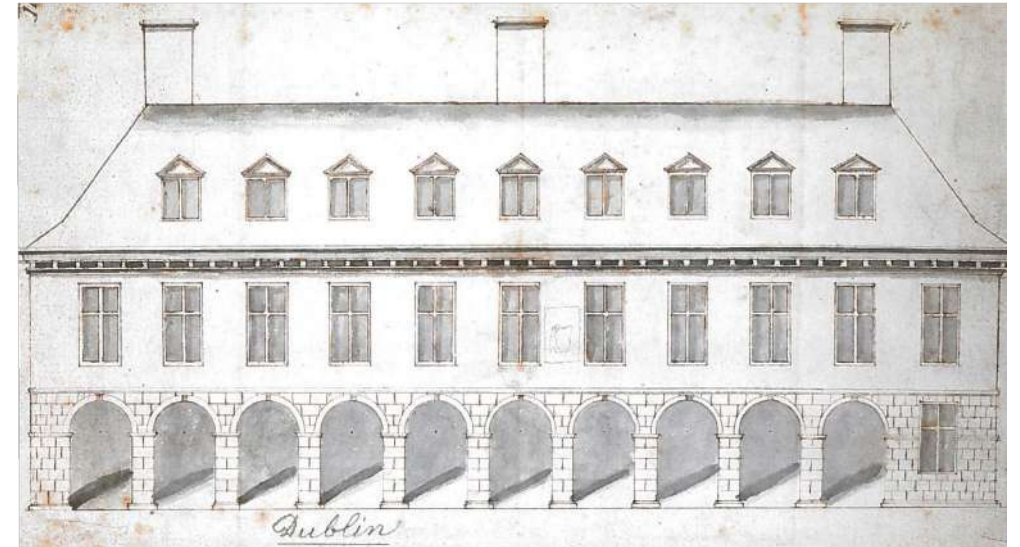




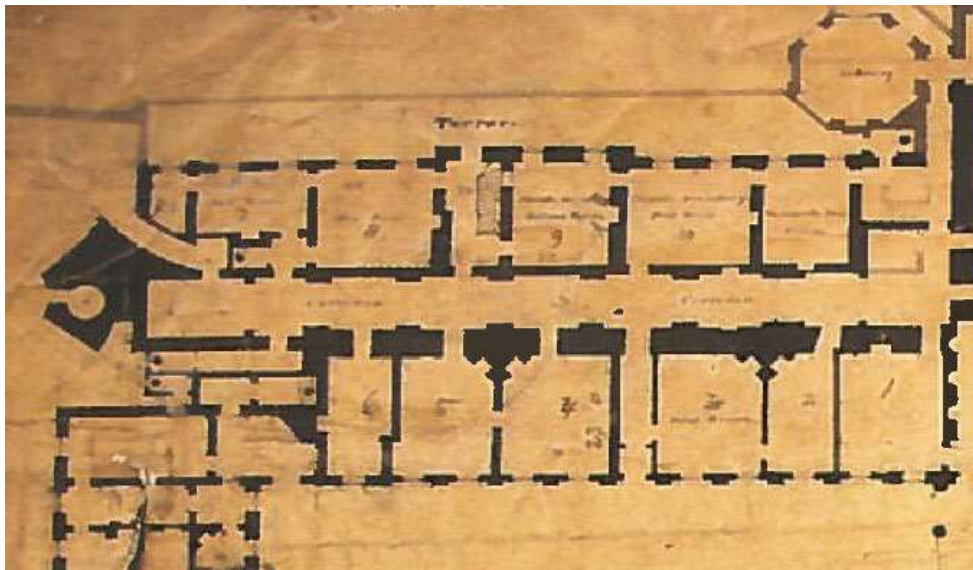




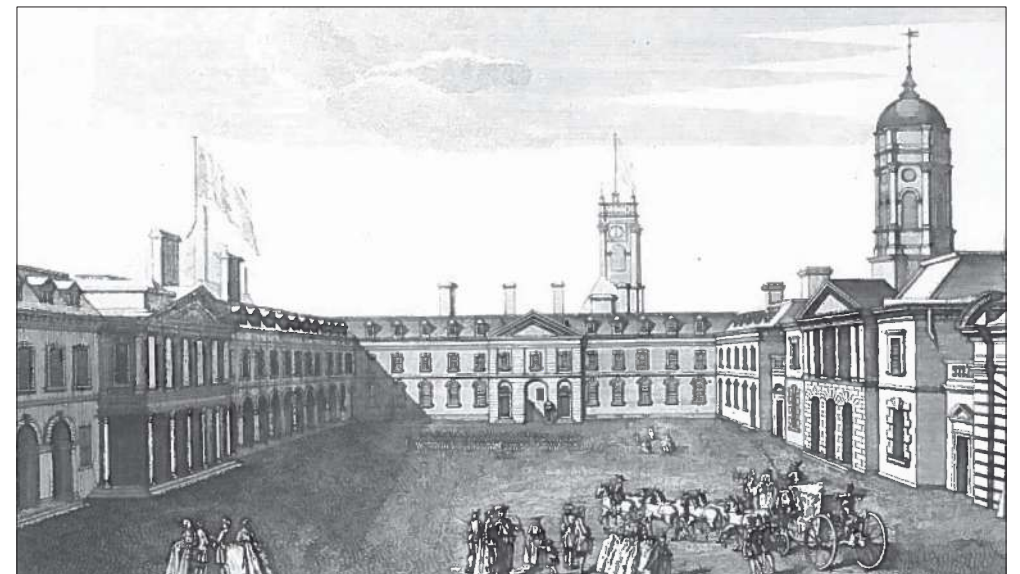
Ground Floor Plan of Robinson Block, 1680s



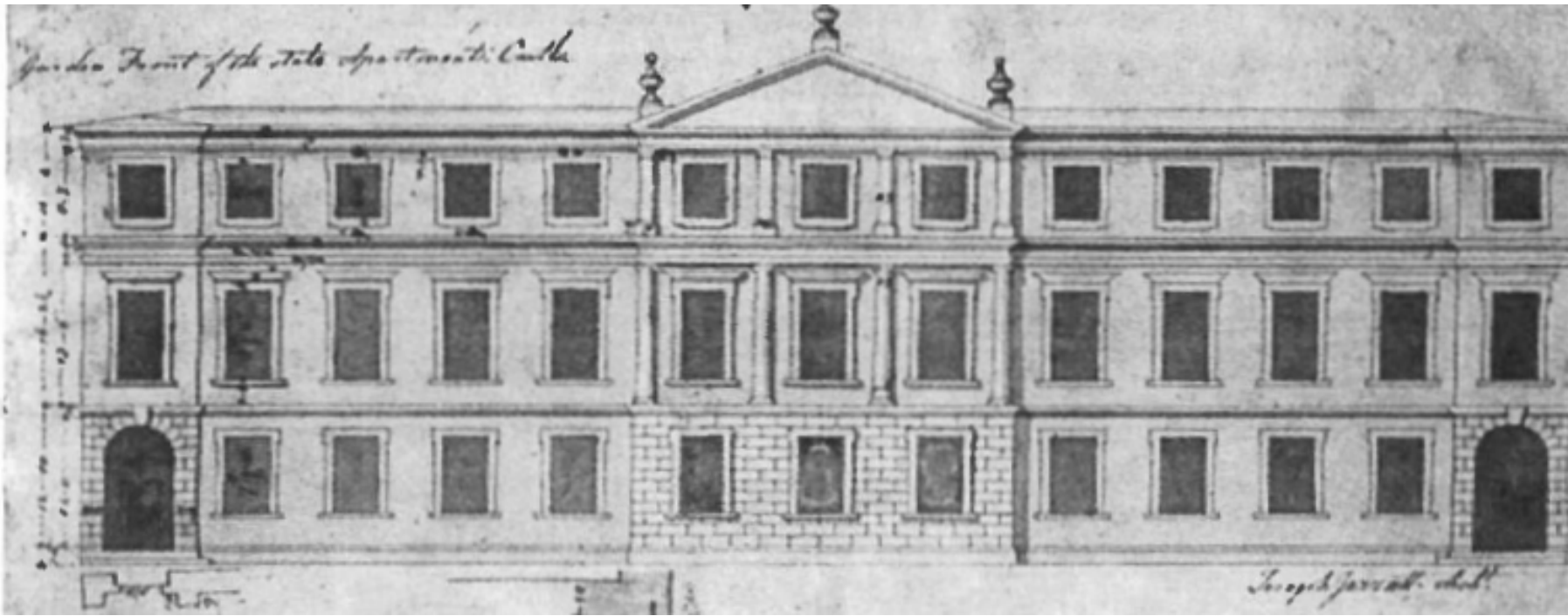
Elevation of William Robinson's new building for the southeast range of Dublin Castle c. 1684

A prospect of the Upper Castle Court from the Council Chamber by Joseph Tudor 1753 (RIA) The State Apartments can be seen on the left hand side.



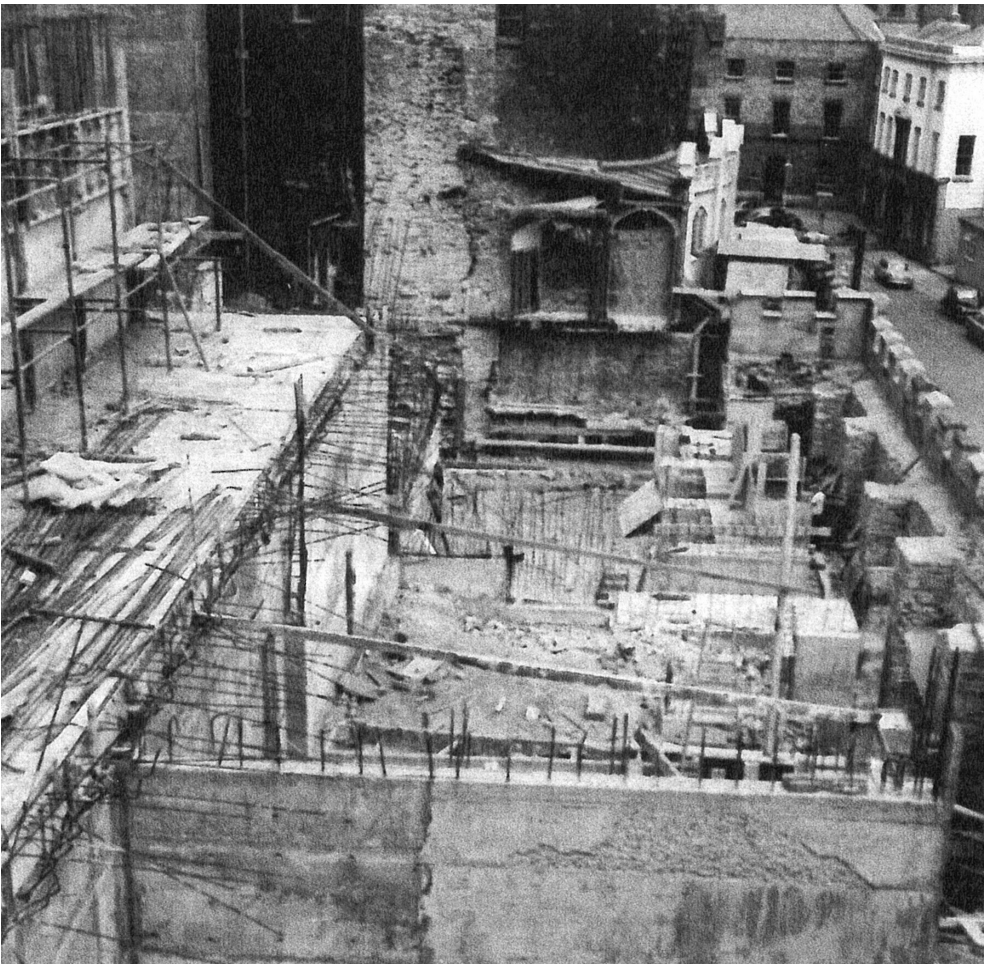
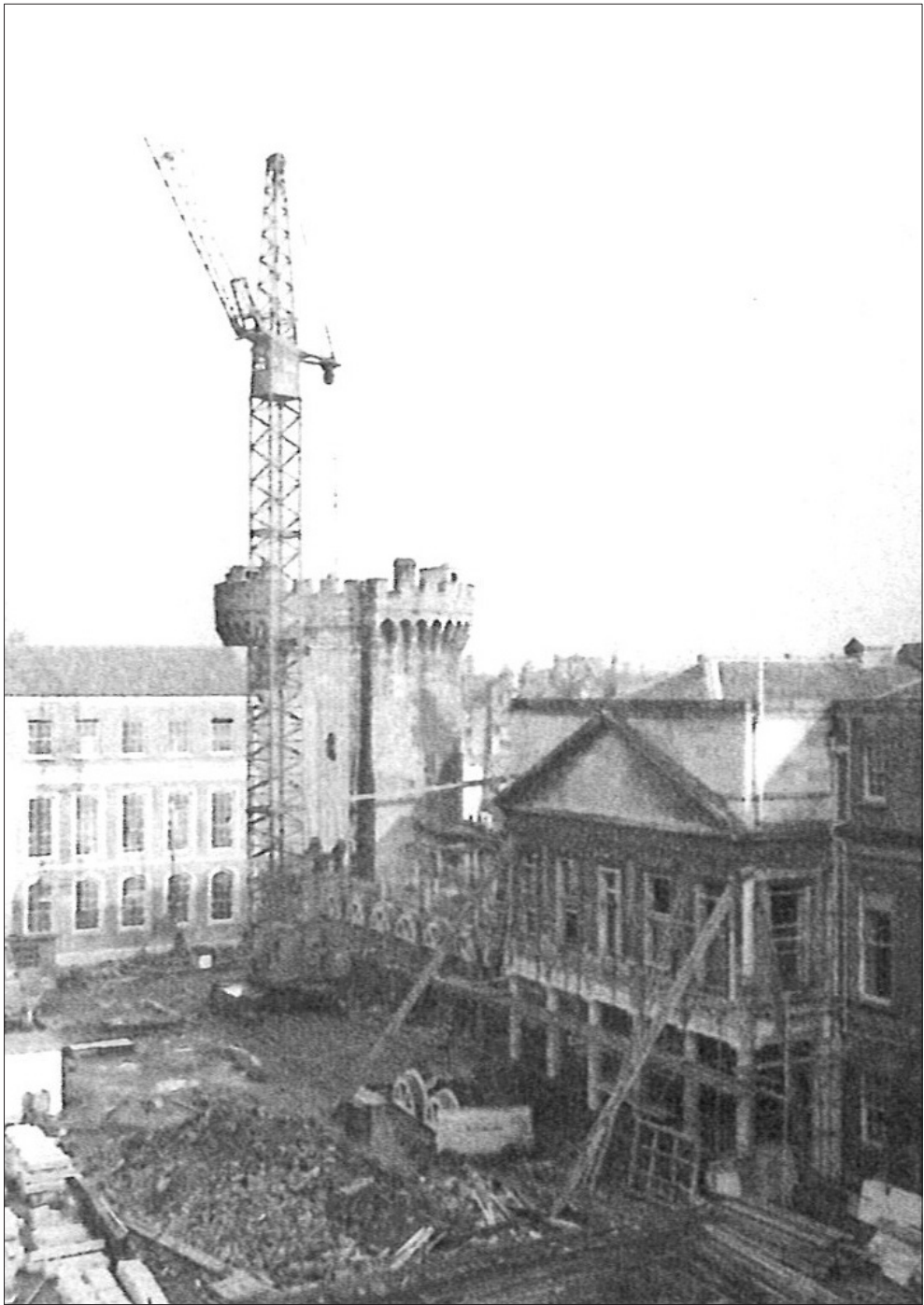
